The Holiday Inn Express hotel is modern & practical, well located on the side of the Canal de la Villette just 3 miles from the very heart of Paris.

Each of the wheelchair accessible rooms has one large bed, with an adjoining room for an assistant, making the experience more spacious & private than usual.

Breakfast will be at the hotel, while most of our evening meals will be taken in restaurants around the area, so that we can enjoy a variety of cuisine and ambience.

As usual, we will have our extensive collection of accessibility aids, including hoist, shower chairs, & mobility scooter, at no extra charge.
