We have just returned from a 10 day holiday based in Gyor (pronounced gYer) Hungary with Makin Tracks. We had 9 days of hot sun and 1 day of rain. Budapest, Vienna and Bratislava (in Slovakia) were great day trips from Gyor. We also visited a Monster fortress (60 cannon trained on the Danube and an interior the size of 4 football pitches) and the monastery at Pannonhalma,
